

Faculty Policies Minutes---October 22, 2007

Minutes from the October 15 meeting were approved.

The revised Student Code of Conduct was presented and approved. It will be forwarded to President Bloodworth.

The Cullum definition and recommendation was presented. Minor typographical corrections were made. The recommendation was approved with one vote opposed. The recommendation will be forwarded to the VPAA with a copy to the Arts and Sciences Dean, since it was recommended that he be in charge of the program.

Myers reported progress on Committee surveys. Most of the surveys are in. The subcommittee will be proofing committee charges and recommend whether or not changes should be made to the committee. Email approval by FPC will be requested for committees that remain unchanged. Committees that are not unanimously approved in this manner or have recommended changes will be discussed at future FPC meetings.

A representative of the Faculty Senate was invited to a "Best Practices in Faculty Governance" Symposium at North Georgia College on November 9. Since we do not have a Faculty Senate, but are instead governed by a Committee of the Whole, FPC agreed to send Rychly as a representative for ASU.

A possible revision of Faculty Manual information on the Academic Policies Committee was presented. The problems with current and earlier revisions were discussed. Further revisions, including possible rotation of membership, were made. A revised proposal will be presented at the next meeting.
