

## Summer 2010 &/ Fall 2010 Registration Steps for Continuing Students

SU/FA10 New undergrads advise/register via New Student Orientation - details: 706-737-1610.

- Review course offerings ([www.aug.edu](http://www.aug.edu), right column, "Course Schedule") and your degree requirements. As you look for open classes, set "term" to target. There are four parts of summer term - sessions #1, #2, #4 all begin May 19; session #3 begins Jun 24. All are compacted to cover a full term course's content - consider summer load very carefully!
- Before registration, work with an advisor\* to discuss your course choices. Contact your advising department for procedure. A worksheet helps organize your registration. Obtain on-line permissions before your registration time. \*If exiting LS this term, see an advisor in your major now so you will be prepared to register after term ends.
- Do you have SU10/FA10 Aid? On PIPELINE'S ELROY tab, check Financial Aid menu. See Financial Aid in Payne Hall promptly with any questions.
- Check your Registration Status on-line before your registration time to make sure you have cleared all holds and/or satisfied any special conditions.
- After your registration time (see chart), log in to Pipeline ([pipeline.aug.edu](http://pipeline.aug.edu)) and register on-line\*. You may register, add and drop courses from your start time until 4:00pm Fri Apr 16. Follow menu instructions. \*If you have holds that require you to register in person, go to the campus site after your time. Students currently enrolled in Learning Support classes register after the term ends (LS: 706-737-1685).
- After registering, confirm amount due by clicking on "Pay by Financial Aid, Credit Card or Check" in the Registration menu, ELROY tab, PIPELINE. Pay fees by deadlines.
- Pay fees on PIPELINE with Financial Aid, check or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover) (note amount before clicking on payment method) or in person by cash/money order at the Business Office, Fanning Hall.

### Summer &/ Fall 2010 Registration

Students eligible for registration, Apr 12-16 may register, add/drop SU10 and/or FA10 classes through PIPELINE (see [www.aug.edu](http://www.aug.edu)) any time after assigned date and time, but not before.

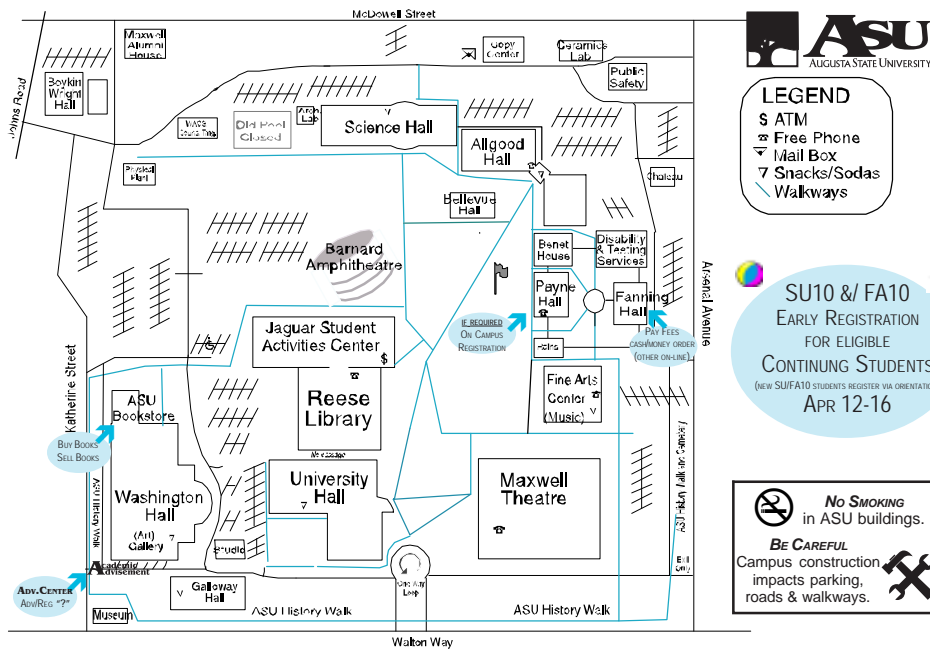

To exit University College, complete 30 hours in Core Areas A-E, including all of Area A; have an Overall GPA of 2.0 or better; satisfy ASUO1000 & any CPC or LS requirements. \*UCOLL with no other holds such as LS, ASUO1000 required, etc.
