

SP10 Registration Steps

SP10 New undergrads advise/register via
New Student Orientation - call 706-737-1610.

- **Review course offerings** (www.aug.edu, right column, "Course Schedule", set term to "Spring 2010") and your degree requirements.
- **Before registration, work with an advisor*** to discuss your course choices. Contact your advising department for procedure. A worksheet helps organize your registration. Obtain on-line permissions before your registration time. **If exiting LS this term, see an advisor in your major now so you will be prepared to register after the term ends. Transients, Post-Bacs, Post Grads, and Audits should seek assistance in the department offering their target courses as needed for prerequisite permissions, etc. (See Admissions for transcript copy to show prerequisites.)*
- **Do you have SP10 Aid?** On PIPELINE's ELROY tab, check Financial Aid menu. See Financial Aid in Payne Hall promptly with any questions.
- **Check your Registration Status on-line** before your registration time to make sure you **clear/satisfy** any holds/conditions.
- **After your registration time (see chart), log in to Pipeline (pipeline.aug.edu) and register on-line***. You may register, add and drop courses from your start time until 4:00pm Fri Nov 20. Follow menu instructions. **If you have holds that require you to register in person, go to the campus site after your time. Students **currently** enrolled in Learning Support classes register after the term ends (LS: 706-737-1685).*
- After registering, **confirm amount due by clicking on "Pay by Financial Aid, Credit Card or Check"** in the Registration menu, ELROY tab, PIPELINE. Pay fees by deadline.
- Pay fees on PIPELINE with Financial Aid, check or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover) (note amount before clicking on payment method); with cash/money order at Business Office (Fanning Hall).
- If eligible following posting of fall grades, you may adjust registered SP10 classes Dec 15-17 on-line. (no in person these dates).
- Visit Academic Advisement for general advisement or registration help.

Spring 2010 Registration

Students eligible for SP10 Registration, **Nov 16-20** may register, add/drop their classes through PIPELINE (see www.aug.edu) any time after assigned date and time, but not before.

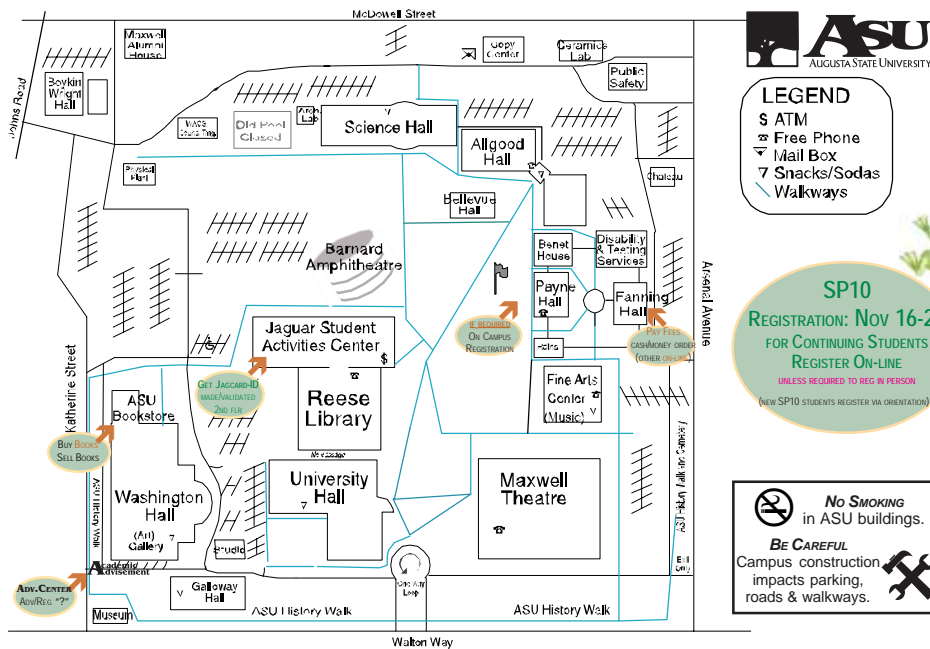

To exit University College, complete 30 hours in Core Areas A-E, including all of Area A; have an Overall GPA of 2.0 or better; satisfy ASUO1000 & any CPC or LS requirements.
