

Summer 2012 & Fall 2012 Registration Steps for Continuing Students

SU/FA12 New undergrads advise/register via New Student Orientation - details: 706-737-1610.

- Review course offerings (www.aug.edu, scroll to bottom, "Course Schedule") and your degree requirements. As you look for open classes, set "term" to target. Summer term has four parts: sessions #1, #2, #4 all begin May 15 session #3 begins Jun 21. All are compacted to cover a full term course's content - **consider summer load very carefully!**
- Before registration, work with an advisor* to discuss your course choices. Contact your advising department for procedure. A worksheet helps organize your registration. Obtain on-line permissions before your registration time. *If exiting LS this term, see an advisor in your major now so you will be prepared to register after term ends.
- Do you have SU12/FA12 Aid? In MyASU, ELROY, check Financial Aid menu. See Financial Aid (Payne Hall, 2nd) promptly with any questions.
- Check your Registration Status on-line before your registration time to ensure you clear/satisfy any holds/special conditions.
- After your registration time (see chart), log in to MyASU account, click ELROY icon, and register on-line*. Register, add/drop courses from your start time until 4:00pm Fri Apr 13. Follow menu instructions. *If you have holds that require you to register in person, go to the campus site after your time. Students currently enrolled in Learning Support classes register after the term ends (LS: 706-737-1685).
- After registering, confirm amount due by clicking on "Pay by Financial Aid, Credit Card or Check" in the Registration menu, (MyASU, ELROY). Pay fees by deadlines.
- Pay fees on-line with Financial Aid, check or credit/debit card (MasterCard, Visa, Discover); with cash/ money order at Business Office (Fanning Hall).
- Following grades, adjust registered SU12 classes May 12-13, if eligible, on-line only.

Summer &/ Fall 2012 Registration

Students eligible for registration, Apr 9-13 may register, add/drop SU12 and/or FA12 classes through My ASU, ELROY (see www.aug.edu) any time after assigned date and time, but not before.

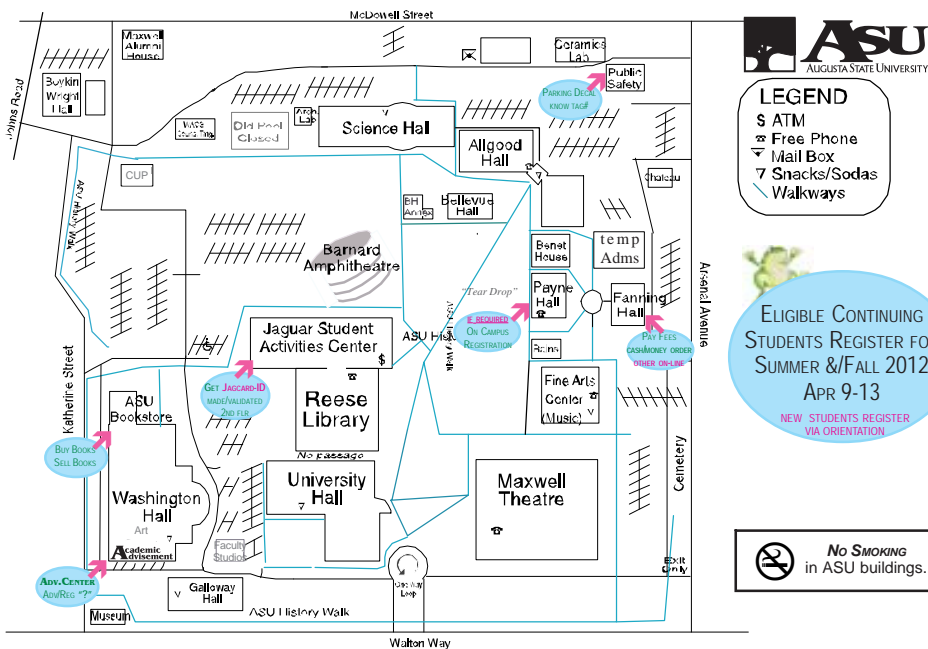
