

# University College - Things to Remember

## \*\*\*University College Restrictions\*\*\*

Students admitted through University College are limited to 12 credit hours per semester (13 if one of the courses is a 4 credit hour course) until they have exited University College. In addition, enrollment is restricted to 1000 and 2000 level courses.

## \*\*\*College Preparatory Curriculum (CPC)\*\*\*

English - satisfied by exiting LS ENGL &/or READ  
Math - satisfied by exiting LS MATH  
Foreign Language 1 - satisfied by 1001 level course  
Foreign Language 2 - satisfied by 1002 level course  
Natural Science - satisfied by any science course in Area D  
Social Science - satisfied by any course in Area E

\*by the course grade on the Academic Summary indicates that the course satisfied a CPC deficiency and **DOES NOT** count toward graduation.

\*\*\*A grade of C is required in the course to satisfy CPC requirements\*\*\*

**Special Note** - if an \* appears by HIST2111/2112 or POLS1101, the computer has counted this course toward fulfillment of a social science CPC requirement. The student will need to take an additional course in Area D. The course **does not** have to be a history or political science.

## \*\*\*Foreign Language CPC Note\*\*\*

If a student only needs the 1002 level to satisfy CPC requirements, the 1001 level may be taken for preparation and may count as “elective credit,” but does not satisfy the CPC deficiency.

To take the 1002 level course without taking the prerequisite 1001 level course, the student must see Languages, Literature and Communication for proficiency testing and permission to enroll.

## \*\*\*To Exit University College\*\*\*

To exit University College a student must do all of the following:

1. Complete 30 credit hours in Areas A-E of the core,
2. Complete Area A of the core
3. Complete ASUO 1000,
4. Clear all LS and CPC deficiencies, and
5. Have a 2.0 overall GPA
