Bachelor of Fine Arts with a Major in Art (General Track)

The Bachelor of Fine Arts program is designed to prepare students for professional careers in art. This track should be selected by students who plan to pursue graduate degrees in art.

Portfolio Review - All art majors are required to submit their work for a review by the studio faculty after the completion of the following courses: Art 1520, 1530, 1211, and 12 additional hours of studio art courses (21 hours total.) Portfolio Reviews are scheduled during the fall semester. The Portfolio Review must take place the academic year preceding the year of graduation.

Senior Exhibition - The B.F.A. degree candidate is required to mount an exhibition of artwork. The work for this exhibition must be accepted by the studio art faculty and judged to be of significant quantity and quality to demonstrate the student's professional abilities. The exhibition is completed in Art 4999 and is a graduation requirement.
