Welcome Aboard

The Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic marked the first tournament for new ASU head golf coach Josh Gregory ... Gregory was named to the golf program's top post by Director of Athletics Clint Bryant on Monday, Sept. 9 at Forest Hills Golf Club ... Gregory spent the previous two seasons as men's and women's assistant coach at North Carolina State, where he helped guide the men's team to a sixth-place showing at the NCAA Championships in Columbus, Ohio ... Gregory played collegiately at SMU, serving as a team captain during his senior season ... He earned a pair of degrees at SMU -- a B.S. in corporate communications and public affairs and a B.S. in psychology ... He spent parts of three seasons as a professional golfer on various mini-tours.

Jaguars Ranked Among Nation's Best

Augusta State began the 2002-03 season ranked 16th in the nation, according to *Golfweek* ... The Jags finished the 2001-02 season ranked 15th in the country by *Golfweek* ... Senior Oliver Wilson, a first-team All America selection as a junior, was tabbed a second-team preseason All-America pick by *Golfweek*.

ASU Makes Mark At The Farm

Augusta State fired rounds of seven-under 281 and 11-under 277 to rally for a second place finish in the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic at The Farm Golf Club ... The Jags finished just two shots back of Clemson and actually led briefly during the final round ... ASU's 11-under third round set a new record for lowest third round in tournament history.

Jags Take On Demanding Schedule

ASU's 2002-03 slate is as daunting as any it has put together in the history of the program ... The Jags opened the season at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at The Ridges in Johnson City, Tenn., against a field that included seven of the nation's top 25 teams ... ASU's invite to the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic was one of the most coveted in the Southeast ... The Jags took advantage of the invite, rallying to finish second, just two shots behind Clemson ... By virtue of its fifth-place finish at the NCAA Championships in June, ASU received an invite to the Ping/Golfweek Preview ... The tournament -- at Karsten Creek Golf Club in Stillwater, Okla. -- will feature the nation's top 12 preseason teams, including Minnesota, last season's NCAA Champion, and the No. 1 team in the preseason, Clemson.

Welcome Back

Senior All-America Oliver Wilson and sophomore Scott Jamieson were back in the lineup when the Jags teed it up in the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic ... The pair missed ASU's fall opener at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at The Ridges, though it was for a good cause ... Each was representing his homeland in the Home Intercollegiate, an event that featured many of the top amateurs from England, Scotland, Ireland and much of Europe ... Wilson paced the Jags at The Farm, finishing alone in third place at nine-under 207 with rounds of 71-67-69 while Jamieson tied for 23rd at even-par 216 (71-75-70).

New Faces Make Early Impact

Senior Brendan Fisher didn't waste any time staking his claim to a spot in the ASU lineup ... Fisher, a senior from Augusta via Ole Miss, spent two-and-a-half seasons in the Rebels' program before transferring home ... Fisher led the Jags with a tie for ninth at the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate at The Ridges in Johnson City, Tenn. ... Fisher carded rounds of 72-72-74 to finish at two-over 218 ... Sophomore Kalle Edberg, a transfer from SMU, broke into the Jags' lineup as well ... Edberg posted 79-77-82 to tie for 70th place at 22-over 238 ... Fisher and Edberg continued their solid play at the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic ... Edberg carded rounds of 75-74-69 for a two-over 218 total and finished 32nd ... Fisher stormed back from an opening-round 86 with rounds of 68-69 over the last 36 holes to finish at seven-over 223 and a tie for 52nd.

Hagler Makes ASU Debut

Freshman Thomas Hagler made his first collegiate appearance for ASU in the Carpet Capital Collegiate Classic ... Hagler (Ringgold, Ga.) enjoyed a solid outing in his first event, posting rounds of 77-72-79 for a total of 12-over 228 ... Hagler provided the highlight of the tournament, carding his first career hole-in-one during Saturday's second round ... Hagler aced the 151-yard, par-3 11th hole at The Farm Golf Club ... Hagler also birdied his first collegiate hole on Friday morning at the 388-yard, par-four 10th.
