# The Administaff Augusta State Invitational

The Administaff Augusta State Invitational has established itself as one of the finest intercollegiate golf tournaments in the nation.

Steeped in the rich golf tradition that is found in Augusta, Ga., the Administaff ASU Invitational has steadily grown since its beginning in 1979.

The Augusta Golf Association (established in 1949), a group dedicated to the promotion of golf in the Augusta area with a special emphasis on junior golf development, has served as the long-time host of the Administaff ASU Invitational. Today, the AGA boasts a membership of nearly 200 business and civic leaders.

In 2006, the Administaff ASU Invitational entered a new era with the relocation of the tournament to Champions Retreat Golf Club in Evans, Ga.

For the fourth consecutive year, the tournament boasted one of the top fields in the nation, with five of the top 20, 11 of the top 31 and 15 of the NCAA's top 62 teams in the field. Coastal Carolina captured the team title and USC Aiken senior Scott Brown claimed medalist honors.

With three distinct nines designed by golf icons and major champions Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer and Gary Player, Champions Retreat Golf Club offers three unique golf settings.

Player's nine features the low country marshes of Euche Creek while the surrounding bluffs are enhanced with Nicklaus's nine. The experience of Palmer's nine includes a 280-acre island with miles of shoreline along the Savannah River.

Forest Hills Golf Club, home to the Augusta State University men's and women's golf programs and host of the tournament from 1979-2005, is very much a rich part of the rich golf history of the area. The course, built in 1926 by famed architect Donald Ross, served for many years as home to the Southeastern Open.

It was at Forest Hills that Bobby Jones began his brilliant play in 1930. Jones himself credited his victory at the Southeastern as the spark for his amazing stretch that saw him claim both the U.S. Amateur and U.S. Open and both the British Amateur and British Open, becoming the first player in history to capture the Grand Slam.

## Administaff ASU Invitational Notes

The 2007 Administaff Augusta State Invitational marks the 29th edition of the tournament ... This year's event marks the third year of Administaff's affiliation with the event and the second year the tourney has been played at Champions Retreat Golf Club ... This year's 18-team field is the largest in tourney history ... Of the 18 participating teams, nine (9) are ranked among the top 29 in the nation in the latest Golfstat and *Golfweek* magazine rankings, as of Tuesday, March 20 ... Clemson (6th in Golfstat, 10th in *Golfweek*) is the highest-ranked team in the field ... Other ranked teams include: No. 8/11 Coastal Carolina, No. 13/14 Tennessee, No. 15/17 North Carolina, No. 17/13 East Tennessee State, No. 19/29 Minnesota, No. 23/27 Georgia State and No. 25/20 Auburn, along with USC Aiken, the No. 6-ranked team in Division II ... Augusta State has won six of the last nine Administaff ASU Invitational titles ... In 2003, the Jaguars set new tournament records for both the lowest team total (820/-44) and individual total (Oliver Wilson -- 199/-17) ... The Jaguars erupted for a final round of 21-under 267, the lowest round in tournament history as well as school history ... In 2005, the 54-hole total of 896 (+32) by Augusta State was the highest winning score in tournament history ... The previous six team champions had finished under par ... In 2005, Georgia's Chris Kirk posted a winning total of one-over 217, the highest since 1989 ... The previous 15 individual winners had shot under par as well ... The last medalist to shoot over par prior to Kirk was Arizona State's Phil Mickelson in 1989 (218/+2) ... In fact, Mickelson's total of two-over 218 is the highest winning individual total ... Augusta College's Roger Rowland (1986 and 1988) and North Carolina's John Inman (1982 and 1983) are the only multiple medalists in tourney history ... The tournament record for lowest 18 holes is 8-under 64 and has been accomplished four times, most recently by Augusta State's Oliver Wilson during the final round of the 2003 event ... A playoff has determined the individual winner in three of the last six years.
