Steeped in the rich golf tradition that is found in Augusta, Ga., the Administaff Augusta State Invitational has steadily grown since its beginning in 1979 and is widely recognized as one of the finest intercollegiate golf tournaments in the nation.

The Augusta Golf Association (established in 1949), a group dedicated to the promotion of golf in the Augusta area with a special emphasis on junior golf development, has served as the long-time host of the Administaff ASU Invitational. Today, the AGA boasts a membership of nearly 200 business and civic leaders.

In 2008, for the sixth consecutive year, the tournament boasted one of the top fields in the nation, with six of the top 10 and 12 of the team 40 teams in action. UCLA claimed the team title and Bruins' junior Lucas Lee captured medalist honors.

Forest Hills Golf Club, home to the Augusta State University men's and women's golf programs and host of the tournament from 1979-2005, is very much a rich part of the rich golf history of the area. The course, built in 1926 by famed architect Donald Ross, served for many years as home to the Southeastern Open.

It was at Forest Hills that Bobby Jones began his brilliant play in 1930. Jones himself credited his victory at the Southeastern as the spark for his amazing stretch that saw him claim both the U.S. Amateur and U.S. Open and both the British Amateur and British Open, becoming the first player in history to capture the Grand Slam.

TOURNAMENT NOTABLES

The 2010 Administaff Augusta State Invitational marks the 32nd edition of the tournament ... This year's event marks the sixth year of Administaff's affiliation with the event and the second year of the event since its return to historic Forest Hills Golf Club ... Augusta State has won seven of the last 10 Administaff ASU Invitational titles ... In 2003, the Jaguars set new tournament records for both the lowest team total (820/-44) and individual total (Oliver Wilson -- 199/-17) ... The Jaguars erupted for a final round of 21-under 267, the lowest round in tournament history as well as school history ... In 2005, the 54-hole total of 896 (+32) by Augusta State was the highest winning score in tournament history ... The previous six team champions had finished under par ... In 2005, Georgia's Chris Kirk posted a winning total of one-over 217, the highest since 1989 ... The previous 15 individual winners had shot under par as well ... The last medalist to shoot over par prior to Kirk was Arizona State's Phil Mickelson in 1989 (218/+2) ... In fact, Mickelson's total of two-over 218 is the highest winning individual total ... Augusta College's Roger Rowland (1986 and 1988) and North Carolina's John Inman (1982 and 1983) are the only multiple medalists in tourney history ... The tournament record for lowest 18 holes is 8-under 64 and has been accomplished five times, most recently by USC Aiken's Roberto Diaz in 2009 during the first round ... Augusta State's Oliver Wilson fired an 8-under 64 during the final round of the 2003 event ... A playoff has determined the individual winner three times in the last eight years.

DIRECTIONS TO DOUBLETREE HOTEL

From Augusta Regional Airport ...

- Turn right out of airport onto Hwy. 56
- Turn left onto I-520 West (Bobby Jones Expressway)
- Take the WHEELER ROAD (1C) exit
- Turn LEFT onto Wheeler Road
- Turn RIGHT at the 2nd red light onto Perimeter Parkway
- Follow the road around and the Doubletree is on your left

From the South ...

- Take US Hwy. 25 into Augusta
- Turn left onto I-520 West (Bobby Jones Expressway)
- Take the WHEELER ROAD (1C) exit
- Turn LEFT onto Wheeler Road
- Turn RIGHT at the 2nd red light onto Perimeter Parkway
- Follow the road around and the Doubletree is on your left

From the East ...

- Take I-20 West toward Atlanta
- Take Exit 196A onto I-520 East (Bobby Jones Expressway)
- Take the WHEELER ROAD (1C) exit
- Turn LEFT on to Wheeler Road
- Turn RIGHT at the red light onto Perimeter Parkway
- Follow the road around and the Doubletree is on your left

From The West ...

- Take I-20 East towards Augusta
- Take Exit 196A onto I-520 East (Bobby Jones Expressway)
- Take the WHEELER ROAD (1C) exit
- Turn LEFT on to Wheeler Road
- Turn RIGHT at the red light onto Perimeter Parkway
- Follow the road around and the Doubletree is on your left

DIRECTIONS TO FOREST HILLS GC

FROM DOUBLETREE HOTEL

- Exit to the **RIGHT** out of hotel parking lot
- At the red light, turn **LEFT** on to Wheeler Road
- Cross over bridge and continue straight through two red lights and past new YMCA and recently-completed construction area
- At the 3rd red light, (a Chevron gas station will be on the corner on your left), turn **RIGHT** on to Walton Way Extension
- Continue straight through red light (you will pass Augusta First Baptist Church on your right, then down a hill and back up and you will pass a library on your right and an elementary school on your left)
- Get into left turning lane and turn **LEFT** onto Wrightsboro Road
- Go past second red light, turn **LEFT** on Magnolia Drive just past Newman Tennis Center
- Go to stop sign and turn **LEFT** and enter Forest Hills Parking Lot
