Assistant Professor of Special Education (full-time tenure track position)

The Augusta State University College of Education invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant Professor in Special Education. The position will begin in August 2010. Responsibilities include teaching, supervising field experiences, advising, conducting research, and providing service to the College of Education, the University, the community, and the profession.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum qualifications include an earned doctorate in special education or related field and experience teaching students with disabilities. College teaching experience and an established agenda of scholarship are preferred. Courses include teaching at the graduate and undergraduate level and include Field-based Internship, Assessment in Special Education, Classroom Management, Characteristics of Students with Severe Disabilities, and Teaching Students with Disabilities in General Education Settings.

DEPARTMENT: The College of Education is accredited by NCATE, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission, and the Southern Association of Colleges and Universities. The Special Education program offers an undergraduate, Master of Teaching, and a Master of Education in special education. Endorsement in gifted education is also offered.
