Assistant/Associate Professor of Counselor Education (full-time tenure track position)

Applicants must have work experience in school and/or community settings and be eligible for licensure in the state of Georgia. Preference will be given to applicants with LPC licensure and/or NCC certification, demonstrated evidence of effective teaching, clinical supervision excellence, and research productivity. Salary is commensurate with training, education, and experience.
