**Assistant/Associate Professor of Educational Leadership (full-time tenure track position)**

Responsibilities include teaching in two areas: Educational Leadership and Research Methodology. Additional responsibilities will include advising, conducting and guiding research, and providing service to the College of Education, the University, the community, and the profession.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Minimum qualifications include earned doctorate in Educational Administration with strong research methodology skills. Preference will be given to Qualitative Research. The applicant must have the ability to teach introductory, intermediate, and advanced research methodology classes. Applicants must have experience guiding doctoral research in educational leadership. Responsibilities include teaching graduate level core courses in Educational Leadership and in Research, serving on department, college, and university committees, collaborating with school districts, and fulfilling service expectations of the University. The applicant should have teaching or administrative experience in K-12 public or private schools.
