Faculty Meeting Minutes

April 30, 2009

Meeting was called to order at 1:00p.m.

The minutes from the April 2, 2009 faculty meeting were approved.

Dr. Jackson asked the faculty to make sure they attend departmental meetings, and to keep their office hours. He added that if they are not able to hold office hours when to let Sekethia know and if possible to send an e-mail to their students through Pipeline.

Dr. Jackson informed everyone that late registration will be held on May 19<sup>th</sup>, and classes will begin on May 20<sup>th</sup>.

Dr. Jackson asked the faculty to conserve office supplies. He asked everyone to post things on-line (e-mail, LiveText, etc.) for students to print for themselves since they are given funds to do so. Doing this will not only conserve paper, but also ink and toner.

Dr. Jackson stated that he is still trying to get someone to come to the department to train the faculty on how to do the Faculty Role Models online.

Dr. Hardy stated that the Educational Leadership field is going through a flux period in Georgia, because they want teacher-leaders. He mentioned to the faculty, putting a new degree together. The degree will be titled Master of Supervisor of Instruction. This will satisfy the need for building level leaders. The new degree will have an Endorsement block and incorporate gifted endorsement.

Dr. Stephens shared with everyone the information she received from attending the "Shooting on Campus" seminar. She will e-mail the information to everyone.

Dr. Lord briefly addressed the faculty and staff as the incoming Department Chair.
