

Dana Foundation Scholarship in Educational Leadership

The Dana foundation will make available to an approved applicant in the Educational Leadership graduate program at Augusta State University (ASU) a scholarship not to exceed \$2000.00 per term (fall, spring, summer) for the sole purpose of paying tuition, books, and fees with Augusta University. Monies from the scholarship will be administered by the financial aid office with Augusta State University.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Eligibility

- Each applicant will complete an application for consideration by the faculty of the Educational Leadership Department (the faculty) of Augusta State University.
- The decision for the scholarship awarded by the faculty and the Dana Foundation will be final.
- The scholarship will be based upon financial need.
- The scholarship recipient shall not receive any other scholarships while a student at Augusta State University and while a recipient of the scholarship.
- No more than one applicant per academic year shall receive a scholarship unless approved by The Dana Foundation.

Application Criteria & Forms

- The applicant must submit a complete application form. Application forms are available on-line (www.aug.edu/clinical) or in the Department of Educational Leadership, Counseling and Special Education.
- The applicant must be a graduate student in Educational Leadership at Augusta State University in either the Masters or Specialist program
- The applicant must comply with any and all requirements for continued enrollment in the Educational Leadership graduate program at ASU per the ASU Catalog as of the academic year the student is enrolled.
- The applicant must submit a written request for continuation of the scholarship to the faculty and the Dana Foundation at the end of each term. The written request should contain an overview of the applicant's progress through the Educational Leadership degree program for the immediate preceding term.
- Failure to meet any conditions or requirements as set forth herein will result in immediate forfeiture of scholarship by the applicant.

Submittal Information

Applications must be received by on or before June 1. The scholarships will be awarded/announced July 1.
