Who can nominate? Any teacher or Administrator. Self-nominations are also accepted.

CRITERIA: The teacher nominated must:

1. be active in FLAIR.
2. be a full-time foreign language teacher in an elementary, middle, secondary school, college or university in the CSRA.
3. have had at least one year of full-time teaching experience in the CSRA prior to the year of nomination.
4. be a member in good standing of at least one state, regional or national professional language organization. (FLAG, ACTFL, SCOLT, AATF, AATSP, AATG, MLA, ACL, etc.)
5. utilize good pedagogical practices in the classroom.
6. demonstrate a keen sensitivity for students' needs and abilities as learners of a second language.
7. have evidence of continuing professional growth and development in at least one of the following ways:
 - (a) study and/or travel in countries where the second language is the official language.
 - (b) attendance at professional meetings
 - (c) participation in foreign language workshops, retreats or institutes.
