The Homecoming Committee will select the MOST SPIRITED Student Organization during Spirit Week Homecoming 2006. Student Organizations are encouraged to participate in sponsoring a candidate, the Spirit Banner Contest, Spirit Week, Paint the Town Blue Day, the Student Organization Day, the Bonfire & Pep Rally, and Homecoming games. Members of the committee will be present at each event to judge the spirit of each organization present. Points will be given for participation in Spirit Week, Spirit Banner Contest, Paint the Town Blue and Student Organization Day, attendance at JAB's Homecoming Ball, the Block Party, Greek Stomp, Bonfire & Pep Rally, Evening of Comedy and basketball games and sponsoring a candidate. The winning organization will receive \$200, a spirit award, and bragging rights for the next year. So pull out all the stops, and get into that Jaguar spirit!!

Spirit Banner Contest: Student Organizations will be given supplies to make a banner on Friday, February 3 from 1 – 4pm at Christenberry Fieldhouse and these banners will be recognized during half-time of the homecoming men's game. See attached info.

Spirit Week: The Homecoming Committee encourages students, faculty and staff to show their Jaguar Spirit during Homecoming Spirit Week. Sunday is Paint the Town Blue Day and student organizations who participate will paint a business window or a banner to hang in that business in the spirit of Homecoming. See below for info. Monday is Hat & Shades Day – wear your favorite hat and shades or your wackiest. Tuesday is Stomp the Cougars Day – wear your stomping shoes (cowboy, hiking, work boots). Wednesday is Student Organization Spirit Day – wear your student organization t-shirt, buttons, letters, whatever to show your pride for your organization. Thursday is the Bonfire & Pep Rally so it is Red Hot Day – wear something red, hot or something that represents red hots, bonfires, blazes. Friday is ASU Blue & White and Show Your Jaguar Spirit Day – wear your blue & white, your ASU gear, show your ASU Pride.

Paint the Town Blue Day instructions: Sunday, February 5, 2005, 2:00-4:00 pm. Share the Homecoming spirit with everyone in the area! The student organization that wishes to participate must select a business, contact that business and confirm that with the Student Activities Office by Friday, January 27. A list of area businesses operated by Alumni will be provided if needed. Student organizations must provide their own supplies. If a business does not have a window to paint, a banner may be hung in the business (again, clear this with the business). The window or banner must have the student organization name, ASU Homecoming date, times of games, and be decorated with Homecoming Spirit. The banner/window must be cleaned up/torn down by Wednesday, February 15.

Greek Stomp Day: Tuesday, February 7, 11:15 am WH Café. Calling all Greeks! Secure your bragging rights for the rest of the year! Come out and support Greek Life at ASU by watching the fraternities and sororities put on a show and be a part of the show yourself!! All organizations interested in being in the Greek Stomp must submit the form below and must meet with Ms. Karen Mobley and get approval before being guaranteed a spot in the show.

Student Organization Spirit Day: Wednesday, February 8 will be Student Organization Spirit Day along the sidewalk from Allgood to University Hall from 10 am – 1pm. Student Organization members should wear their t-shirts, buttons, letters, to show their pride and spirit for their organizations. Student Organizations who are interested in participating in this day should provide information about their organization and any pertinent college issues they endorse and an activity at their booths (a game, display, info on the club, recruit). Student Organizations that have sponsored a candidate MUST have a booth. See the form enclosed in this packet.

Pep Rally & Bonfire: Thursday, February 9, 6:30 -9:30 pm, University Village. The Pep Rally & Bonfire will feature the 2006 candidates, the Pep Band, the dance team, Cheerleaders, Athletic teams and coaches, Mr. & Ms. ASU 2005, and student organizations. Candidates will have an opportunity to introduce themselves to the crowd. Student Organizations should be there to support their candidate AND show their spirit for our JAGUARS!! Food, music, cheering, a blazing fire and giveaways to those most spirited – that's a great event!!
