April 21, 2004

The Committee's "Faculty Satisfaction Survey" was revised, printed and distributed as planned at the last meeting. Dr. Cadle and Dr. Nelson sent out reminders to the faculty. The surveys were due back on April 21, so they had already begun to come in. So far, just over eighty have been returned. The results will be analyzed over the summer and reported in the fall.

Dr. Nelson reported on the plans for the new Student Center which will be built in front of and connected to the Library building. He reported that Special Collections would be moved to the newly renovated space on the third floor during the first three weeks of May. He also reported on the expected renovation of the present Special Collections area on the first floor on the Library which will be used by Institutional Research.
