1. Marya DuBose, PKP National Fellowship Director, presented information on PKP fellowships to the executive committee members. She noted changes in the PKP mission statement to include service to the community. PKP has adopted "literacy" as its first service initiative. Some funding will be available for projects that promote literacy. Several fellowship brochures and posters were distributed. Marya discussed tips for students applying for fellowships and distributed tip sheets for students and faculty. Paul Harris suggested keeping fellowship applications in the Honors Program Office for easy access for students. Paul will discuss this plan further with the Honors Program Director. Marya noted that PKP will soon have DVDs available to help with certain functions such as initiation. PKP members were encouraged to send a representative to the national convention in Albuquerque this year. President Bloodworth will be the keynote speaker.

2. Miyoko Jackson reported on the initiation committee. She indicated that last year's members were being asked to serve again. She also asked for ideas regarding decorations for the initiation ceremony.
