3. There was a discussion about having a calendar and/or flowchart of deadlines and events to help move things along. There is a calendar on the PKP website that is still helpful, but needs updating.
4. Peggy Ruth urged that members of the Executive Committee and other members of the Chapter attend the triennial national convention in 2007 in Orlando, Florida.
5. There was review of the plans and state of the arrangements for the remaining events in this year's lecture series: ASU's Arsenal of Literacies: Reading the World.
6. Peggy Ruth suggested that the Chapter adopt the ASU Literacy Center's new tutoring program at the MCG Children's Medical Center as an official project. Paulette Harris can give the Chapter the details.
7. There was discussion of the PKP scholarship opportunities and how best to identify eligible students and encourage them to submit applications.
8. There was discussion on how to involve new initiates, particularly those from the junior class, into the events and activities of the Chapter. We will change the wording on the initiation invitation letters by adding wording that strongly encourages them to take the opportunity and responsibility to become active in PKP now and in the future.
9. There was discussion about getting a list from the national office of PKP members in the CSRA and contacting them about joining the ASU Chapter.
