## REGISTERING EARLY AT ASU...

**SPRING '99 NEW STUDENT OARS**  
**THU DEC 17 - 10:00AM**

- **OARS is Augusta State University's comprehensive orientation program.** New accepted undergraduate students may register early by participating in the entire OARS process. The full program guides you through registration, explaining the steps involved, providing helpful tips, advising you with course selection, and registering your classes. The entire process should take approximately 4 hours.

- **To be eligible to register through OARS, you must first have completed your admissions process including any required testing, or outstanding documents** (certificate of immunization, official transcripts, etc.).

**IMPORTANT:** Bring all support documents with you to assist in your initial registration (for example, financial aid/scholarship information, acceptance letter, Transfer Credit Evaluation, notification of Advanced Placement or College Preparatory Curriculum deficiency).

- **Arrive at the Maxwell Performing Arts Theatre about 20 minutes early** to allow ample time to obtain your registration materials, locate your seat, and review your OARS booklet, before the program begins promptly at 10:00 AM. (Late Arrivals will not be allowed to register.)

- **As part of the registration process, you will receive advising support** in the department which corresponds to the major (or undecided status) you indicated during the admissions process. (Students participating in the Learning Support program are advised by that department.)

**OARS TIP:** Contact Admissions (706-737-1632) prior to your initial registration if you wish to make any changes such as major, admission quarter or address corrections.

- **Fees will be due on the day you register.** Fees may be paid with officially awarded financial aid, cash, check, MasterCard, Visa, and Discover.

- **Depending on departmental loads and your preparation, you should complete the entire registration process, including fee payment, by about 2:00 PM.**

- If you do not register early through OARS, then you register on the following general registration days:

SPRING '99 GENERAL REGISTRATION: MON-TUE JAN 4-5 according to the published campus registration schedule for your classification (Freshman, Sophomore, etc.). Post-Bac, Post-Grads, Audit, Transient, (not eligible for OARS) register by category on the above general registration days according to the published campus registration schedule.

*If you have any special assistance needs, please let us know at least three days in advance.*
