Assistant/Associate Professor, Language and Literacy (full-time tenure track position)

The Augusta State University College of Education invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant/Associate Professor in Language and Literacy. The department seeks candidates with experience teaching P-12 Language Arts/Literacy courses. The position will begin in August 2012. Responsibilities include: teaching four courses each semester (undergraduate and graduate level courses), supervising field experiences, advising, conducting research, publishing, grant writing, and providing service to the College of Education, the university, the community, and the profession.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum qualifications include an earned doctorate in literacy education or curriculum and instruction with a focus on literacy or a closely related field and teaching experience (minimum of 3 years of P-12 classroom teaching experience). It is preferred that the candidate have extensive knowledge of research (qualitative or quantitative) and experience in grant writing. College teaching experience and an established agenda of scholarship are preferred. The new professor will be expected to participate in future program expansions.

DEPARTMENT: The College of Education is accredited by NCATE, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission, and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. The Department of Teacher Education offers undergraduate degrees in early childhood, middle grades, secondary, and P-12 education. Graduate degrees offered include the Master of Arts in Teaching, Master of Education, and Educational Specialist degree.
