ASU CareerLink is an online system that allows ASU students and alumni to access postings for part-time and full-time employment and internship, co-op and volunteer opportunities.

Students apply for opportunities through the system and post their resumes for employers to view.

Do all students and alumni have ASU CareerLink accounts?

All currently enrolled students and recent alumni have ASU CareerLink accounts. Alumni who graduated more than a year ago, must contact the Career Center to create an account, 706-737-1604.

How do I access my ASU CareerLink account?

Go to the Career Center website, www.aug.edu/career_center, and click on the ASU CareerLink logo. Then log-in with your 927# and the password = success.

How do I apply for opportunities listed in my ASU CareerLink account?

Simply upload your resume to your account and submit your resume for positions posted under the "Jobs" section of your account.
