

Graduate E-Portfolio Update for M.Ed. and Ed.S. Students:

This fall, we are rolling out a new portfolio template and rubric for our advanced programs. The new template incorporates the Conceptual Framework Principles of Prepared, Able, and Responsive, or PAR. For each principle, you must include three artifacts, for a total of (10 for exemplary status).

Please note this is less than the old template which required 21. One important change is the evidence of technology implementation. One artifact per principle (a total of 3 technology artifacts) must demonstrate technology integration.

You will find that this new template is well aligned with your courses as your professors have already been implementing PAR in their classes. The new rubric also reflects these changes. It is very specific about the criteria for the portfolio, thus making it clearer for both the student and the instructor grading the portfolio.

If you are graduating in the Fall of 2010, you have the option of using the new template or the old one which uses NBPTS standards. However, if you are graduating AFTER Fall 2010, you MUST use the new template. The old template will be unavailable after November of 2010.

As always, we strive to make certain that our programs are current and implement best practices. We feel certain that this is a change that will improve our advanced programs.

E-portfolios will be evaluated as part of the final courses in our graduate programs. M.Ed. portfolios will be evaluated in EDTD 6410 and Ed.S. portfolios will be evaluated in EDUC 7003. You will submit your portfolios by the end of the 13th week of your final semester in the program. Professors teaching those courses will be responsible for the evaluation of your portfolio.
