Pre-Admit Early Childhood Education Majors

ECE Pre-Admit Checklist:

- Student must familiarize themselves with the Teacher Education Website – www.aug.edu/teacher_development/
- Student must familiarize themselves with “First Year Ed Majors FAQ’s” – http://www.aug.edu/teacher_development/graduate.htm
- Student must familiarize themselves with “Early Childhood Education Track Sheet” and stay aware of their ongoing requirements.
- Student must check their ASU email account twice a week.
- Student must be advised each semester before registering for courses.
- Student understands he/she should not wait until registration to schedule an appointment.
- Student must apply for admittance to Teacher Education. Spring applications will be due on November 1st and fall applications will be due on April 1st. This requires a meeting with your advisor for approval. See application online at the Teacher Education Website noted above.
- Student must provide copies of all Test Scores (SAT, ACT) if exempting GBS (GACE Basic Skills).
Note: SAT scores of 1000 or higher or ACT scores of 43 or higher required for exemption.

Note: collegeboard.org (866-756-7346) is a resource to obtain Standardized Tests previously taken and not on file at Augusta State University.

- Student must provide a copy of the GBS test (if not exempted) to the department (Charlene Blankenship) for Application purposes. Passing Scores of 220 on all 3 GACE Basic Skills Assessments are required: Test I – Reading (Test 200), Test II – Mathematics (Test 201) and Test III – Writing (Test 202)
- Student must have a GPA of 2.5 or above for Teacher Education Admittance.
- Student must earn a “C” or better in all courses utilized on the track sheet.
- Students must pass the REGENTS Test requirements as well as complete Wellness 1000 and 2 one hour activity classes before graduation and preferably before admission to the program.
- Regents Test Requirements – Reading – 61 & Writing – 2
- Student can have no more than one class left (it cannot be a Humanities course) to take before Admittance to Teacher Education (exceptions are made for the two ISCI classes)

- Student is responsible for getting all Course Substitution Forms from the appropriate department(s) with required signatures and responsible for confirming course substitutions through Registrar's Office.
- Student is advised to complete Wellness 1000 and 2 Activity courses before Admittance (recommended but not required).
