

**Minutes from the Student Technology Fee Committee Meeting  
October 29, 2004**

The Student Technology Fee Committee met at 10:00 am, October 29, 2004 in Media Services. The committee chair for this year is Rose Axton, Director of Media Services. Those in attendance included: Ms. Rose Axton (Media Services Director), Dr. Bill Dodd (Associate VP for Academic Affairs, ex officio and nonvoting), Mr. Chip Matson (Director of IT Services), Rick Pukis (Chair of ITS Committee), Fay Verburg (Reference Coordinator for Reese Library), Ginny Loveless (Office Manager for Reese Library) and Natalya Delgado (student representative). Three additional student representatives, Jerry V. Bautista, William Smith and Samuel Barth (SGA President) were unable to attend.

After calling the meeting to order, the student technology fee budget was discussed. There was roughly \$352,466 collected in student technology fees of which only \$152,466 is available for spending since \$200,000 is committed to have technology installed in University Hall for the next three years. Approximately \$480,737.84 in requests have been submitted.

Since Rose will be out for the remainder of the semester, Dr. William Nelson will be the student technology fee chair in her stead. All questions and comments should be directed to him.

Rick Pukis (ITS Committee chair) spoke on behalf of Jim Garvey and stressed to the committee the importance of funding the upgrades to ASU's Avid editing systems. The Avid system is the industry standard for creating and editing video and film.

Chip Matson encouraged the committee members to consider funding the Microsoft Campus agreement, campus Pipeline and WebCT/Vista Support. All of these are USG supported and should be funded. It was brought up that since these requests are so important to ASU, maybe they should be funded elsewhere. Dr Dodd will inquire.
