Unlimited network access for students to complementary Book Review Digest and Essay & General Literature Index. Book Review Digest provides book summaries and reviews of over 500,000 books, cites thousands of periodicals, and hyperlinks to various sources. Broad coverage of fiction, nonfiction & reference works in the humanities, social sciences, and general sciences. Essay & General Literature Index covers over 65,000 essays in more than 5,000 books in the English language covering multiple disciplines. Students find precise articles using an easy search system. Both of these are standard sources for a university. There is nothing comparable in GALILEO.
