JSTOR (journal storage) is an electronic journal collection of core research titles which provides students and faculty full-text access to essential scholarly literature in Arts & Sciences, Business, Ecology & Botany, General Science and Music. The backfiles of these journals are available 24/7/365 to any ASU current I.D. cardholder from any computer with internet access. No lost issues, no mutilation, no space. The backfiles of these core journals have been digitized up to the last year to seven years ago depending on the journal. ASU fills in the gap between JSTOR and current issues by subscribing to products such as Project Muse, Wilson OmniFile and various GALILEO provided resources.
