Brief summary of the project:

Workstations for art students in Ceramics and Sculpture Labs, one in Ceramics and one in Sculpture. Each workstation would have a scanner, printer, graphics tablet, Photoshop, Dreamweaver, digital camera - the tools an art student needs to work with art images digitally. Currently, art students have a simple used computer to use in Ceramics and Sculpture. They have no graphics software, and only an old black and white printer that works occasionally. But students love these computers and use them constantly. With real art workstations, students could photograph their actual artwork and then correct the image digitally, or build exhibitions on the web, or work on class presentations.
