Brief summary of the project:

Heart rate monitors are used as part of our Wellness 1000 course. Students use the monitors to follow their exercise heart rate as par to the class activity. This is a behavioral method that motivates students to adopt an active lifestyle. Last year technology fees paid of 18. Another 18 would enable our department to outfit an entire class at one time. We have approximately 36 students per class and teach 8-10 sections per semester. Approximately 1,200 students take Wellness each academic year. Additionally, HR monitors will be used b your graduate and undergraduate majors programs. HR monitors are in schools and fitness facilities and our majors need to know how to employ them.
