Brief summary of the project:

Allows students access to information locked away in larger works, with information on over 65,000 essays from some over 5,000 collections published in the U.S., Canada, and Great Britain. Some 320 volumes indexed annually, plus more than 20 selected annuals and serials. Students find the precise articles they need, with searching by keyword, subject, title, author, date of publication, or any combination. Find related articles at a click: each citation links to a list of other works in the collection, others by the author, and others on the subject, as well as to an entry for the source collection. Works of literary criticism are searchable by names.

Estimated cost for years 2 and 3: 8-10% increase each year
