Grove Music Online offers students over 45,000 articles on people and places, instruments and techniques, genres and styles written by over 6,000 international contributors. There are over 5,000 links to images, sound, and other related web sites and over 500 audio-musical examples. There is wide range of search and browse options to explore the full text, bibliographies, works-lists, biographies, and links. It gives access to over 20,000 biographies. It includes articles on world cultures including Africa, Asia, South American and Israel. It covers styles and movements – from classical to hip-hop and from baroque to blues.

Estimated cost for years 2 and 3: 8-10% increase each year
