Brief summary of the project:

The planned availability of technology for classrooms in the Science Building includes removing the chalkboards and installing Wall Talker surfaces (walltalker eraserite). This request is to install now the surfaces in classrooms NSB E-1051 and E-1047.

With a new faculty member hired to begin in the fall, I will now have two faculty members who are allergic to chalk. The faculty member already here has been writing on overheads; this requires a stack of sheets to be cleaned after each lecture. For the new faculty member, even this is inadequate; the strings of chemical reaction equations require the full length of a board in order to be followed by the students and to make sense.
