Symplicity/NACELink enables ASU students to be pre-populated into an online system where they have instant access hundreds of local listings and linked to thousands of career/intern leads nationally. They can apply for jobs, publish resumes for employers to access and search employers virtually for on campus interviews/job fairs. We can impact students in all phases of career development from the freshman-senior year and survey our student/employer users. It provides a technological forum that integrates students, employers and our office together to meet the career development and employment needs of students.
