



Dear Professional:

In order for a student to receive course and testing accommodations based on a physical disorder (e.g., mobility disorders, systemic disorders, sensory disorders, and other disorders), this office must receive the following documentation:

A written statement by an appropriate physician which includes the following items:

- a) A definitive diagnosis
- b) The nature of the functional impairment
- c) The length and severity of the impairment
- d) How the disability currently manifests in substantial limitations
- e) Include suggestions for appropriate accommodations
- f) Documentation must include the names, signatures, titles, and license numbers of the appropriate evaluators, as well as the dates of testing and contact information. Evaluators must be licensed professionals whose training and licensure status is consistent with expertise in the disability for which they provide documentation
