



Dear Professional:

In order for a student to receive course and testing accommodations based on a psychiatric disorder/psychological disorder, this office must receive the following documentation:

An evaluation by an appropriate licensed professional (psychiatrist, licensed psychologist, neurologist). This evaluation must include the following items:

- a) A definitive diagnosis and corresponding DSM code
- b) Description of the history, current symptoms, and severity of the disorder
- c) Description of the expected progression or stability of the disorder
- d) Description of the current functional limitations impacting academic performance resulting from the disorder
- e) Documentation must include the names, signatures, titles, and license numbers of the appropriate evaluators, as well as the dates of testing and contact information. Evaluators must be licensed professionals whose training and licensure status is consistent with expertise in the disability for which they provide documentation
