**Dear MATH 1111 Student:**

In this course you will be using CourseCompass, a course-specific website built specifically for this class. Your instructor may post announcements, the course syllabus, lecture notes, homework assignments, or exams. Once you register, you will have easy access to all your materials with just a few clicks!

**Before You Begin:**

To register for CourseCompass you will need:

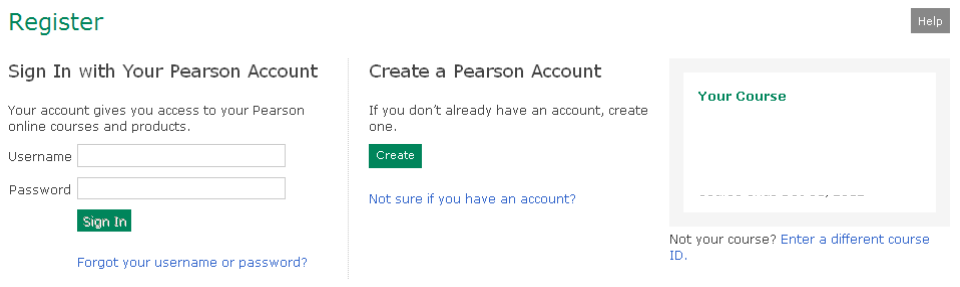
- A “Course ID” provided by your instructor:** \_\_\_\_\_
- A CourseCompass student access code** (packaged with your new textbook, available for purchase at **www.coursecompass.com**, or available for purchase at the ASU bookstore)
- Your school’s zip code:** 30904
- A valid ASU email**

**Student Registration:**

1. Enter **www.coursecompass.com** in your Web Browser.
2. Under **Register**, click Student.




3. Enter your **Course ID** exactly as provided by your instructor, and click **Continue**.
  - a. Your course information should appear. If not, contact your instructor to verify the correct Course ID.
  - b. If you registered for CourseCompass during a previous semester, you may sign in. **Do not register again.**
  - c. If you have never registered for CourseCompass, click **Create**, and complete the registration process.
  - d. If you do not remember whether or not you are registered in CourseCompass, click “Not sure if you have an account?”.



4. Simply follow the registration screens and enter your information as prompted. If you request temporary access, read the information below carefully.

#### Change your temporary access to full course access

To pay for full course access:

From the MyLab / Mastering home page, click **Sign in**.

1. Click the "Pay or use an access code" link under the course for which you want to pay.

Your temporary access expires in **17 days**. [Pay or use an access code now](#)

**Note:** If your temporary access has already expired, click the "Pay or use an access code" link in the expired subscription window. You will need to enter your course ID, so be sure to have that available.

2. Choose your payment method:

- If you already purchased an access code, you will click **Access Code**, enter the access code in the boxes, and click **Finish**.
- If you plan to use a credit card or PayPal, you will click the button for the access you want. Next, add billing and payment information, then review and submit your order.

3. You will receive a confirmation page; click **Go to Your Course** to continue your work.

5. Once your registration is complete, you will see a **Confirmation** screen (this information will also be emailed to you). Simply print your confirmation and you are now ready to log in and access your resources!

#### Logging In:

1. Enter **www.coursecompass.com** and click **Sign in**.
2. Enter the **login name** and **password** you created, and click **Sign in**
3. You will see your **course** listed on the left; click on this link.
