

MATH 2008 Mathography

The purpose of this assignment is two-fold. First of all it will help me get to know you better. Secondly, it is designed to encourage you to think about your own experience with mathematics. Share your thoughts by responding to the following two prompts. Please write in narrative form (typewritten, double-spaced, 12 pt font). You should write at least one page but no more than two pages. The assignment is worth 10 points; 7 points will be credited based upon the extent to which you have addressed the items below and 3 points will deal with your technical writing (that is, is your paper grammatically correct and is it coherent?).

Tell me about yourself:

- What are your interests, talents, hobbies?
- Other than school, what responsibilities (job, family, etc) do you have?
- What else should I know about you?

Describe your history as a mathematics learner. You may wish to include:

- The earliest experience you remember as a mathematics learner
- Anecdotes that shed light on your feelings, thoughts and attitudes about learning mathematics
- School mathematics experiences
- Non-school mathematical experiences
- Successes and/or failures related to learning mathematics

Submit the assignment through Vista as an attached Word document. Save your document as:
