

Quiz Grading Scale

Note: The most important thing about quizzes is to attempt the problems assigned.

Grades have the following meanings:

- 5: Great work. All problems correct, except for perhaps a careless error or two.
- 4: Good work. All problems attempted and mostly correct.
- 3: Decent work. All problems attempted and some good work, but a few big errors made.
- 2: Needs improvement. Some understanding, but lots of big errors or at least 1 problem not attempted.
- 1: At least you turned something in.

If you were to achieve 3's on all quizzes, your course quiz grade will be 90.

Each 5 earns you +3 additional points.

Each 4 earns you +1 additional point.

Each 2 costs you -2 points.

Each 1 costs you -4 points.

Each 0 costs you -10 points.

The maximum course quiz grade is 100.

Missing a quiz because of an excused absence will have no effect on your course quiz grade.

Your first unexcused quiz will have no effect on your course quiz grade.

If your work is copied verbatim from another student's quiz, you will receive a 1.
