The departmental exam for MATH 1111 is scheduled for **Wednesday, May 5, 3:30 – 5:30 pm**. The location of your exam will be announced later.

All MATH 1111 students are expected to take the exam at the scheduled time. In order to receive a passing grade in MATH 1111, you must satisfy **both** of the following conditions:

- 1) You must have a final course average of at least 60, including your grade on the final exam. The final exam counts as at least one third of your course average.
- 2) You must respond correctly to at least nine out of the 30 final exam items. Nine correct corresponds to a grade of 40 for the final exam; 15 correct corresponds to a grade of 60.

If an undue hardship makes it impossible for you to take the exam at the regularly scheduled time you may request an incomplete (I) for the course grade. Conflict with work will not ordinarily be considered an undue hardship. Requests for incomplete grades must be made to your instructor, and approved by the department chair, prior to the exam time. Incompletes are discouraged and will be given only with sufficient and convincing documentation.
