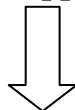

2. ***Mandatory ISL Conference*** at ASU: March 24, 2012

(8:00-2:00 PM University Hall) (You must register on-line.) *\*You can count all these hours as part of your seminar hours but you are still required to attend all seminars provided at your school so many of you may end up with more than the minimum required 10 hours of seminars.)*

3. ***Apprentices must also attend seminars during apprenticeship provided by PSN schools.***

#### Seminar Policy

Apprentices are required to participate in a minimum of 10 hours of seminars. These hours are normally acquired in the PSN schools. Apprentices can earn seminar credit hours by being included in the normal professional development of the PSN faculty, for example, training during faculty meetings and/or separate meetings that the Building Coordinator sets up. Apprentices may also acquire some seminar hours through mandatory seminars conducted at ASU. ASU typically offers 1-5 seminar hours depending on the semester. Mandatory ASU seminars are posted on the Teacher Education web site each semester.

Record the date attended, seminar title, and time frame for each meeting at ASU as well as seminars scheduled at your Apprentice school in a word document, insert in the *Other Documents* section on the *Additional Artifacts* page of the E-Portfolio. (\*Be sure and include the total amount of hours for the seminars at the end of the document.)

This requirement is listed on the Apprenticeship Exit Interview E-Portfolio Checklist.
